**The Eleventh (almost) Annual
Stanley Thompson golf tournament
July 28-30 in Supernatural, Whistler BC**

This is the draft itinerary and estimated costs for the Stanley Thompson XI.



Transportation:

From Vancouver, share or rent a car - 2 hours; or take a bus to Whistler- 3 hours. Public transportation is about \$65 each way. Google: YVR Whistler transport. There will be brothers with cars in Whistler so renting a car is optional.

Accommodations:

Montebello

This development of chalet/townhomes is a 10 minute walk to the Whistler Village and features:

- 3 bed/3 bath units at about \$400 per night for each unit.
- Each unit consists of a master BR with ensuite, plus
- a second bedroom with two single beds and ensuite,
- plus another bedroom with ensuite (just outside the door to the room).
- There is also a living room with fireplace and sofa bed, full kitchen, dining room and patio with a hot tub.

Notes:

These units offer a range of room choices and costs. For example the occupant of the MBR could pay \$150, the single room \$100 and the double room \$75 each for a total of \$400 per night. We should be able to rent one to several of these units depending on response.

- These golf prices (taxes are extra) are as available in 2014. Some specials are likely to be possible at less cost as we get closer. For example, a Whistler passport is available allowing play at each of the four courses for a total of \$500. The fourth course being the Chateau Whistler.
- Chateau Whistler is the only course requiring an electric cart which is included in the price. The Chateau course is quite demanding for high handicappers but is worth the price if only for the views.
- The other courses are all easily played without electric carts.

Non golfers can enjoy hiking, biking, zip trekking, white water outings, gondola and or chairlift to the alpine. Great dining and a village with entertainment.
